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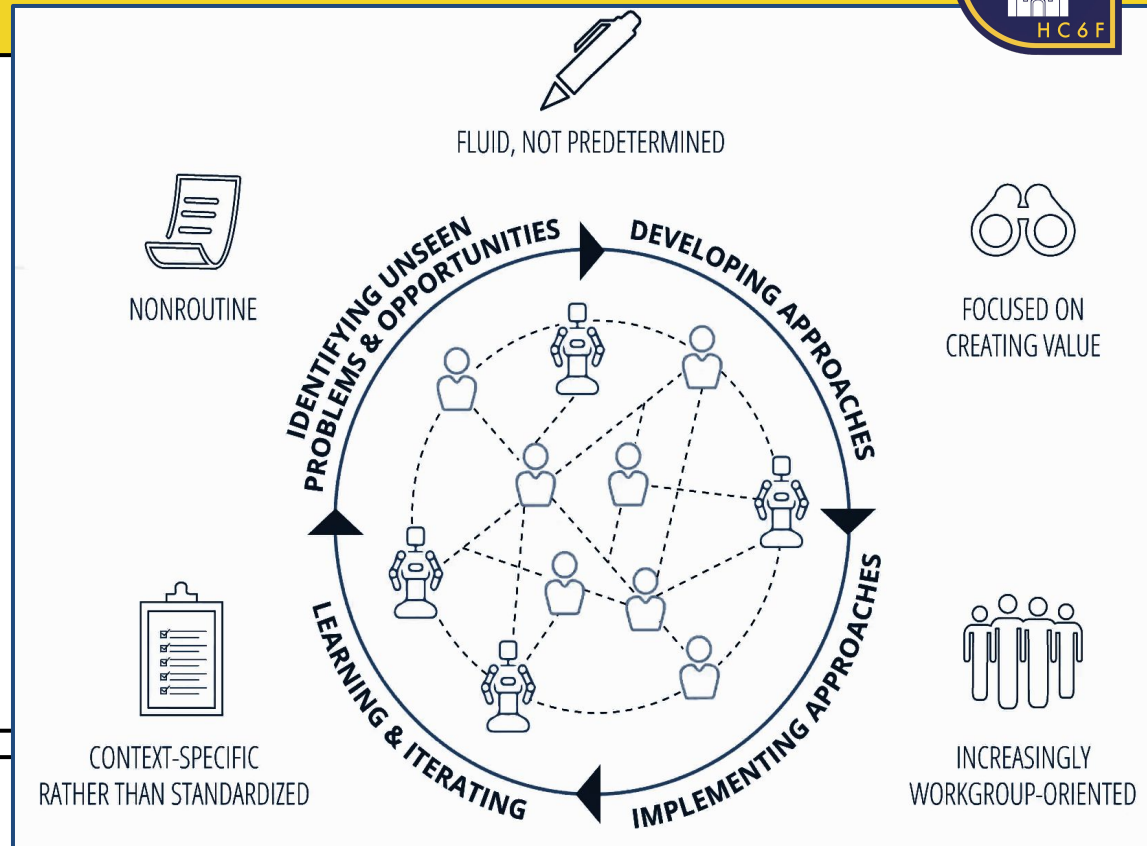

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You can take a **combination** of **A Levels** and **VTQs**.

A significant majority of large companies have recruited employees with a **Vocational or Technical** qualification.

The number of students with a mixture of A Levels and VTQs accepted into UK Higher Education courses has more than tripled in the last 10 years.

All students will be offered guidance and support to ensure they are on the right pathway to suit their needs and aspirations.

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HC6F - Destination Success

The majority of our students go on to study at Higher Education. Around a third of our students enter **Universities** ranked in the **top third** (17% nationally).

Typically, around a quarter of our students go on to **Russell group Universities** (13% nationally).

An increasing number of our students (around 20%) secure **higher apprenticeships** with top companies such as Barclays, Bentley and JCB.
