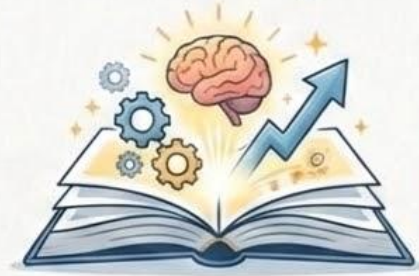
What is on offer at our Sixth Form College?

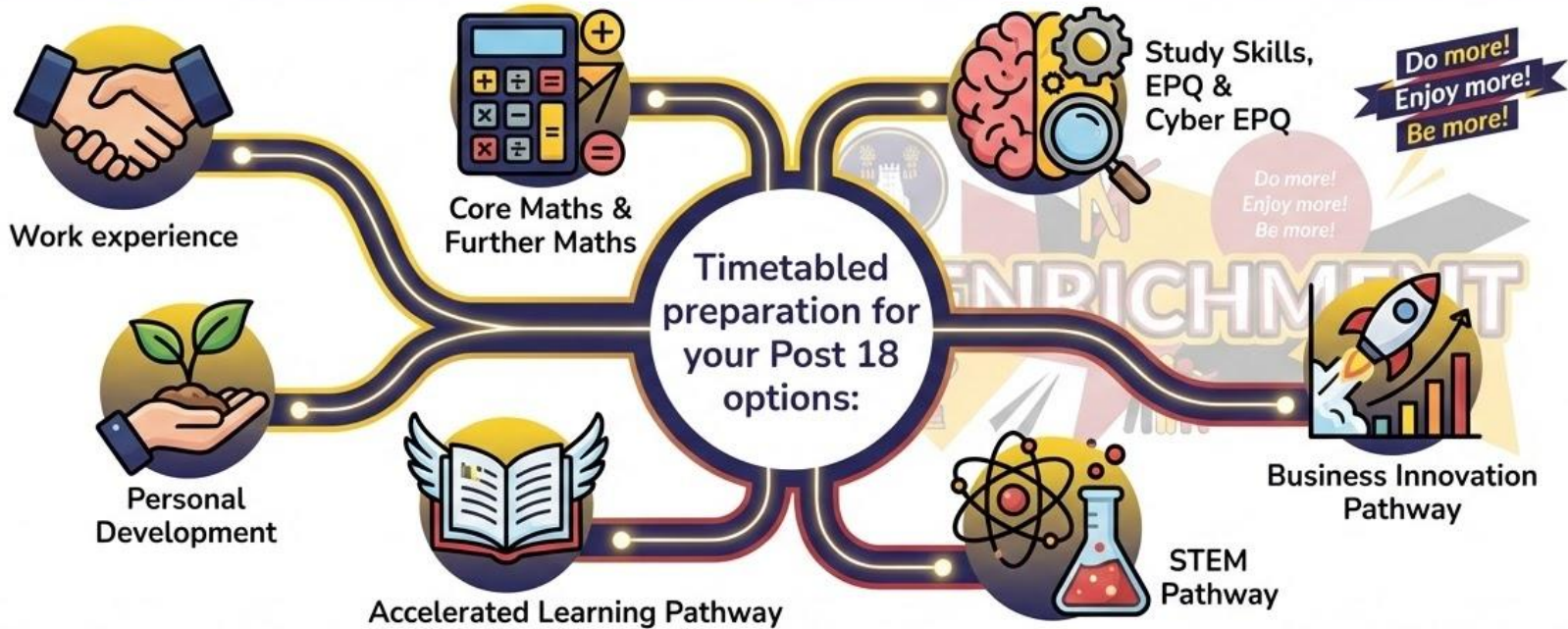
