



## 16-19 Tuition Fund

The Government had introduced the 16 to 19 tuition fund which is a £96 million one-off funding for the 2020-2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced for schools, colleges and all 16-19 providers to mitigate disruption in learning arising from COVID-19. Our share of this funding is £2472.

The guidance related to the fund means that:

- Only learners who do not have a 5-9 pass of either or both English or Maths GCSE at the end of KS4 can benefit from this fund.
- The fund is not limited to supporting GCSE Maths and English and can be used for any aim on the learner's programme of study.
- The need for support will be determined and agreed between eligible learners and staff.
- Typically support will be in the form of small group tuition over and above the teaching timetable for that subject, increased progress support from learning intervention manager, academic mentoring, increased online resources and preparation for next destinations.
- The impact of this will be monitored based on student performance and progress in their courses and preparation for future destinations.
