<u>Textual variations and</u> <u>representations</u>

Analytical skills are developed in this unit using linguistic terminology. Students will learns to analyse texts separately and in comparison.



Child language acquisition

Students will explore how and why children learn to communicate through speech and writing.

Language and diversity

Students will explore how elements that make up a person's identity impact language used. Language topics include gender, age, sexuality, ethnicity, occupation, accent and dialect.



<u>Language change</u>

An opportunity to explore the history of the English language: how and why it has changed over time and continues to do so.
