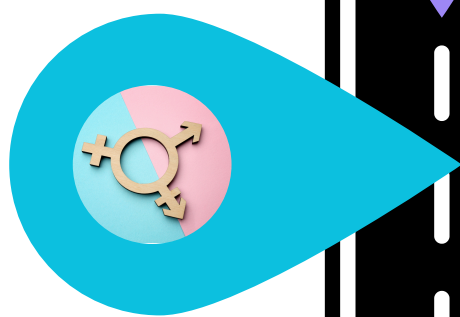

There are 2 NEAs in English language: 1) Original writing and commentary 2) Language investigation. Both are independent pieces of work.

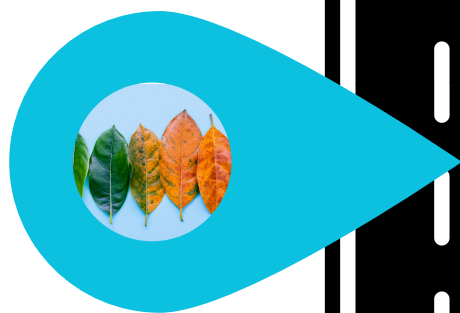


Language and diversity

Students will explore how elements that make up a person's identity impact language used. Language topics include gender, age, sexuality, ethnicity, occupation, accent and dialect.

Textual variations and representations

Analytical skills are developed in this unit using linguistic terminology. Students will learn to analyse texts separately and in comparison.



Language change

An opportunity to explore the history of the English language: how and why it has changed over time and continues to do so.

Child language acquisition

Students will explore how and why children learn to communicate through speech and writing.
