Bespoke Pathway

4 A level subjects, average grade 7 or higher including English and Maths

A combination of an A level and BTEC courses & English or Maths GCSE resit.

5 grade 4's but not including English or Maths.

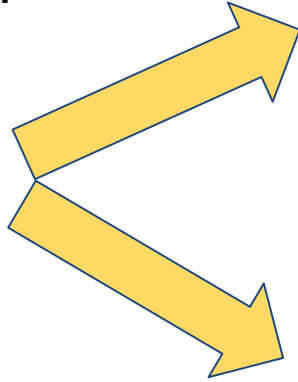

Accelerated Learning

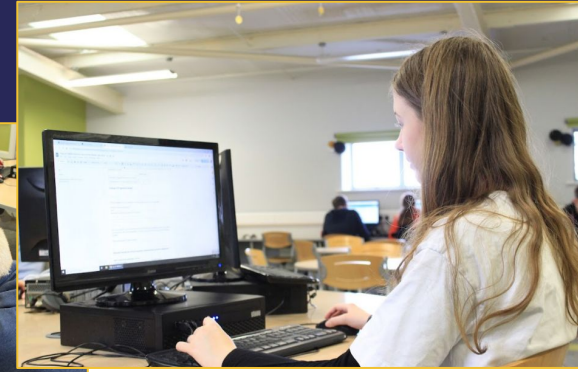
- Advice on writing a high impact personal statement.
